

Survey “Street Smarts”

- Conduct surveys in a public place where you will not be alone, and avoid any situation in which you are uncomfortable.
- Approach individuals cautiously.
- Introduce yourself and briefly tell people about the survey. Let people know that their participation will help to increase funding for badly needed homeless services.
- Assure people that their names will not be taken, and their responses will remain completely anonymous.
- Let respondents know that they can skip any questions they don't feel comfortable answering.
